- Each fixture will consist of 3-matches, see table above.
- Each match will consist of 4-Pairs 601 best of 5-legs.
- Points awarded as follows:
 - 4-0 win = 5 points
 - 3-1 win = 4 points + 1 point to losing team
 - 2-2 drew = 2 points each
 - 1-3 loss = 1 point
 - 0-4 loss = 0 points
- After 3-fixtures, each group winner qualifies for finals night on 3rd May 2017 at Kelvedon Labour Club.
- Finals night is a knockout competition with the semi-final draw being:

BRIGHTLINGSEA vs SOUTHEND

BRENTWOOD vs CRESSING

Format 601 best of 7-Legs with 2 games being played simultaneously in both semi-finals & final, therefore venue must have two boards in same room/area. If after 4-games the scores are level, then the team losing the fewest legs are declared winners. If Legs are equal, then each team to select a pair for a 3-legged decider.
